The Beatitudes are the first eight lines of the Sermon on the Mount in Matthew's gospel, the heart of Jesus' teaching, and a guide to following Jesus and his way of life. They were intended for his disciples who became apostles, which means the Beatitudes are meant as Jesus' guide to leadership.

In this parish training, Dan Ebener, the author of "Blessings for Leaders," and facilitator of our strategic planning, will share his insights on the Beatitudes as they relate to parish leadership. He will facilitate interaction about the insights of parishioners as they explore ways that the Beatitudes can inspire us all to new leadership in the Church.
